We are excited to announce that we have booked a trip for Year 3 to the Wyvern Theatre on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September 2024.

Lawn Primary School will be working in partnership with The Royal Ballet School's Primary Steps Programme. Specialist teachers from this world-famous organisation will be visiting our school, delivering a unique educational experience through five weeks of creative ballet workshops for all year 3 pupils. These workshops will take place on Wednesday mornings and the children will need to wear their PE kits.

As well as the workshops, year 3 pupils will have the chance to watch primary and secondary students from The Royal Ballet School perform a ballet class demonstration at the Wyvern Theatre and we guarantee they will be inspired at first hand by the focus, discipline and talent of these young dancers. This demonstration will take place on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September.

***All children will need a packed lunch on this day.***

The Royal Ballet School's mission is to nurture, train and educate exceptional young dancers from all backgrounds for the Royal Ballet companies, and other leading UK and international companies.

The Primary Steps Programme is where it all begins, offering an engaging introduction to ballet both as an art form and a physical discipline and we hope that many of our year 3 pupils will want to continue dancing through the Primary Steps after-school classes run locally, or in other ways.
