How many queens? Who was the shortest serving monarch?

<u>Maths</u> Work out the length of each monarch's reign. Who had the shortest reign? Who had the longest?	<u>Writing</u> Write a letter to the king, ask for his support on an issue close to your heart.	<u>Mental Health and Well-Being Task</u> Choose a day to spend completely 'offline', fill your day with other things you enjoy doing. If you enjoy this, why not repeat it another day?
<u>Art</u> Draw a portrait of a monarch of your choosing.	<u>Map Task</u> Mark a map of the UK with all the places of Royal residence.	<u>Read</u> Read all about the Duke of Edinburgh award. https://www.dofe.org/ Is this something you would be interested in?
<u>D/T</u> Create a model of a home fit for a king/queen.	<u>Music/Poetry</u> Create a piece of music that could be used as a fanfare.	<u>Research</u> Choose a specific monarch and find out all about them. Present this information however you like.
