**Year 5 “I LEARN Experience Day” – Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025**

We are pleased to invite all Year 5 Pupils in our local Primaries to an “I LEARN Experience Day” at Lawn Manor Academy; Year 5 pupils are often very interested in thinking about Secondary school at this time, as you will soon be making your choice on where your child will transfer to.

Lawn Manor Academy’s vision is *‘Inspiring and Creating Futures for All,’* and this extends to our staff and pupils driving everything we do throughout the school, but with a particular focus on teaching and learning. The school has a culture of being supportive and friendly with a set of strong I LEARN values (Independence, Literacy, Equipment, Attitude, Resilience, and Numeracy) weaved through our daily practice. Lawn Manor Academy is part of the Ascend Learning Trust, which consists of a group of seven schools in Swindon and Wiltshire who work closely together with the shared vision that together we Belong, Believe, Become. Staff and pupils benefit hugely from this close working relationship with the group of schools in the Trust and it also enables our pupils to have a sixth-form progression route to the academic sixth form at Royal Wootton Bassett Academy.

Pupils from Lawn Primary School are invited to spend the day at Lawn Manor Academy on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025, and we write to inform you of the following details:

Pupils will be walked to Lawn Manor Academy by their Year 5 teachers and arrive for 9:15am.

Pupils will participate in an ILEARN day linked to the Geography curriculum in our Forest School.

Year 5 pupils should wear old clothes and footwear suitable for outside work in the Forest School site; a requirement for Forest Schools is that pupils have their arms and legs covered. Please be mindful of this, even in hot weather.

Lunch will be provided for all pupils. The children will have choice of sausage beans and chips or macaroni cheese and garlic bread. If they prefer, they are able to bring in their own packed lunches.

Pupils should bring a water bottle and sun cream if permitted by their own primary school.

Pupils will finish their day at Lawn Manor Academy at 2:30pm and will be walked back to Lawn Primary School for collection.
