Who are the indigenous people of the Amazon rainforest? Can you find out about their culture?

<u>Maths</u> Can you find out how much area the Amazon rainforest takes up? How does it compare to ten years ago, even fifty years ago?	<u>Writing</u> With all of the deforestation taking place, write a letter to the Prime Minister to persuade them to take action to stop people cutting down the rainforest.	<u>Mental Health and Well-Being Task</u> Now that it is getting lighter in the evenings and the weather should be getting better, go on a nature walk, listening to the sounds of nature. See how much wildlife you can spot. Share it with us.
<u>Art</u> Using items you have found outside like leaves, sticks, feathers, shells etc, make a collage inspired by the rainforest.	<u>Map Task</u> Mark all the rainforests in the world on a map, what do you notice about where they are located? Can you name them?	<u>Read</u> Read all about the work that David Attenborough does to support conservation. If you wanted, you could make a poster about him.
<u>D/T</u> Create a 3D model of the different layers of the rainforest.	<u>Music/Poetry</u> Write a poem in any style inspired by the noises that the animals in the rainforest make.	<u>Research</u> Choose a rainforest animal and find out about their lifecycle, present this information however you like.
