Packing suitcase challenge

Draw or list 5 things you would pack for:

a snowy country

a hot desert

a rainforest



Art/craft

Can you create a shoebox habitat for either a hot place, desert, jungle, ocean, or cold place? What animals might you find there?



Understanding the world

Sharing/odds and evens-
