Here are some ideas to help you learn your spellings:

Create with colour

Write your words with each letter in a different colour.

spelling

Look, say, cover, write, check.

Look at the word carefully and say it out loud. Cover the word. Pinch the sounds on your fingers then write it. Check your spelling and correct it if needed.

Rainbow writing

Write your words with all the colours of the rainbow. You can write over the top of each word in the different colours, or make a rainbow using the words. Each word is a different colour.



Colourful 'special friends'

Choose two different colours to write your spellings with. Write the special friends in one colour and the rest of the word in the other.

purple

Sand/salt/flour or sugar writing

Spread a layer of sand, salt, flour or sugar into a small tray. Using your finger, practise spelling the words.



Letters

Use magnetic letters, scrabble tiles or alphabet blocks to spell the words.
