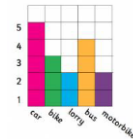
Relaxation

Plant some seeds in pot and see how they grow!

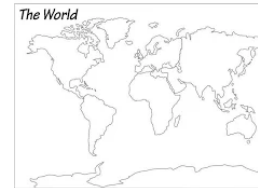
Maths

**Geography**

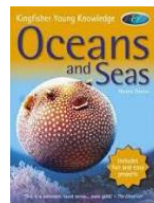
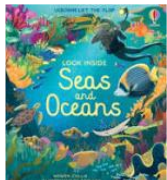
Create a fact file on one of the animals you might find living in our oceans.
